

General Information

Purpose To expose young golfers to the basic and advanced techniques of competitive golf as taught on the collegiate and professional levels and have a good time in the process.

Dates There are three different sessions from which to choose: two one-week sessions and a two-week session. Golfers may attend either of the first two sessions, June 6-10 or June 10-14, or may choose to attend both sessions, June 6-14.

Tuition The cost of attending the Cowboy Golf Camp is \$1,100 for a one-week session and \$2,200 for the two-week session. The tuition covers all instruction, room, board, green fees and practice ball expenses.

Registration Please fill out and return the attached application form. An advance registration deposit of \$500 or \$1,000 (depending upon the session) must accompany each application. The balance of the tuition is due at the time of registration. There will be no refunds for any reason after a young man has been accepted. Send the completed application and deposit to:

Arrival and Departure Registration will be from noon to 2 p.m. on the first day of camp in the lobby of the complex to which you are assigned. Camp instruction begins at 3 p.m. that day. Campers will be free after 1 p.m. on the final day of the camp and they should be picked up at the dormitory by 3 p.m.

Health and Safety Full-time counselors will be available to help ensure the safety of each student during camp sessions and in the dorm.

Who is Eligible Junior golfers between the ages of 11 and 19. Under NCAA rules, senior graduates may attend camp.

Clothing and Equipment You will be required to bring the following: golf attire, laundry bag, toilet kit, sunscreen, golf hat, spending money (\$20-25 per week), sheets, pillow, blanket and towels.

Housing and Food You will be housed in an air-conditioned apartment on the Oklahoma State University campus. Students will be assigned two-to-a-room and will eat their meals in the dining hall and at Karsten Creek. Meals will be all you can eat!

Camp Size Limits Each session will be limited, so mail your application early to reserve a spot. Every session will be organized by ability level for more effective instruction.

Transportation A shuttle service between Stillwater and the Oklahoma City airport will be available. Reservations must be made via your enrollment form or by calling 405-269-6293 (Alan Bratton). Reservations must be made at least one week prior to arrival and please try to be at the airport before noon on the first day of each session. Cost of the shuttle will be \$20 round trip.

Last Day of Camp is Tournament Day All parents are invited to come out early and watch the tournament. Action begins at 8 a.m. at Karsten Creek.

Mike McGraw

Cowboy Head Coach and Camp Director

In his first five seasons as head coach of the Cowboy golf program, Mike McGraw has seen his team claim 21 tournament titles, including the last four Big 12 championships and the 2006 NCAA championship. In 2006, his success did not stop with the national title as he and his team garnered four national awards, coming away with the National Coach, Player, Freshman and Scholar-Athlete of the Year. The Big 12 Coach of the Year in 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010 and 2011, McGraw captained the United States to victory over the European squad at the 2007 Palmer Cup. Prior to his appointment as Cowboy head coach, McGraw directed the Cowgirl squad, leading OSU to the 2005 Big 12 Championship. The 2009 national coach of the year, McGraw also spent seven seasons as an assistant for former Cowboy head coach Mike Holder. During that span, McGraw was named the national assistant coach of the year in 2003. He captured nine combined high school state titles in 11 years at Edmond North and Edmond Memorial.

Mike McGraw will serve as the camp director. He will be assisted by several outstanding collegiate coaches: Kyle Blaser of Oklahoma City University; Alan Bratton, head women's coach at OSU; OSU assistants Brian Guetz and Courtney Jones; Bill Montigel of TCU.

Also working the camp will be Karsten Creek Head Professional Rob Land and long-time Ada High School coach Mark Kedy. Additionally, there will be several collegiate players on staff.

Brian Guetz ... Assistant Men's Coach...two-time All-American at Oklahoma State...played professionally on the Nationwide, Canadian, Asian and Gateway tours from 1997-2009...won the Colorado open in 1994 and 2004...Served as Assistant Coach at Colorado State prior to joining the Cowboy Coaching staff in 2011.

Alan Bratton ... Head Women's Coach, Former All-American at Oklahoma State, played the PGA Tour in 1999 and Nationwide Tour in 2000...also worked at Ping in the Tour department for three years before joining the Oklahoma State coaching staff as the Assistant Men's Coach from 2004-2011.

Courtney Jones ... Assistant Women's Coach...played collegiate golf at University of Tulsa...two-time Academic All-American. AJGA Tournament Director from 2007-2011...Asst. Captain for 2011 PING Junior Solheim Cup team prior to joining Oklahoma State Coaching staff in 2011.

Kyle Blaser ... began his coaching career at Jenks High School where his Trojans won the 1997 5A Oklahoma State Championship ... in his 14 years at Oklahoma City University, his teams captured the 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2006, 2007 and 2010 NAIA national championships ... GCAA Coaches Hall of Fame inductee ... has been named the national coach of the year six times.

Bill Montigel ... Is currently in his 24th season as the head coach at TCU ... his Horned Frogs have won eight conference championships ... has won conference coach of the year honors in separate NCAA Division I conferences ... he has coached 14 All-Americans during his tenure.

Rob Land ... Head Golf Professional at Karsten Creek... PGA Professional for 14 years and is a graduate of New Mexico State University...Came to Karsten Creek after working at The Stock Farm Club for 11 years in Hamilton, Montana...Played High School golf at Edmond Memorial for Cowboy Golf Head Coach Mike McGraw.

John Stemm ... In his 10th Season at OSU ... Stemm is responsible for all aspects of the strength and Conditioning program as well as athletic health care of Cowboy Golfers ... has worked with former Cowboys David Edwards, Chris Tidland, Charles Howell, Hunter Mahan, and Rickie Fowler.
